are able, reduce the number of sprays used until they have stopped completely. Smokers aiming to reduce cigarettes should use the mouthspray, as needed, between smoking episodes to prolong smoke-free intervals and with the intention to reduce smoking as much as possible. As soon as they are ready smokers should aim to quit smoking completely. When making a quit attempt behavioural therapy, advice and support will normally improve the success rate. Those who have quit smoking, but are having difficulty discontinuing their mouthspray are recommended to contact their pharmacist or doctor for advice. Under 12 years: not to be used.
